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Day 3 - Wildlife Resiliency Full-Scale Exercise (0800 – 1400)

Participants:

Participation is open to all personnel and encouraged.

Participants selected for Operations Section Wildlife Branch positions will serve in operational leadership and coordination roles.

Participants who are not assigned to these positions will be assigned to field response roles, such as Wildlife Reconnaissance and Recovery or Wildlife Rehabilitation Teams to gain hands-on experience and a broader understanding of wildlife rescue and rehabilitation operations. This approach allows participants to gain valuable cross-functional experience, increase familiarity with field operations, and strengthen coordination between Incident Management Team personnel and operational responders.

Description: This Full-Scale Exercise (FSE) will involve the activation of the Operations Section Wildlife Branch and include the deployment of personnel and equipment in a real time operational environment to test interagency and interorganizational collaboration, coordination, communication, and implementation of established plans and procedures.
